# Practical Travel Information

## Visa & Arrival

Many nationalities enjoy visa-free entry to Botswana. Check your status well in advance via the official **Botswana Immigration E-Visa portal**. Visa on arrival is available for some nationalities; fees vary.

Your private airport transfer from **Sir Seretse Khama International Airport (GBE)** is fully included. Your dedicated guide will greet you personally with a Touristlads sign. Excess luggage can be safely stored at your lodge.

## Passport & Insurance

Your passport must be valid for a minimum of **six months** beyond your return date. Comprehensive travel insurance with emergency medical evacuation cover is **mandatory** – not optional – for participation in this safari.

## Health Precautions

Recommended vaccinations include Hepatitis A & B, Typhoid, Tetanus, and Yellow Fever (for travellers arriving from at-risk countries). **Malaria prophylaxis is strongly advised** for northern and delta regions. Please consult your GP or travel health clinic before departure.

## Luggage Allowance

Maximum **20 kg per person** in soft, flexible bags for easy 4x4 loading. One small daypack and camera equipment may be kept in the vehicle. Excess luggage can be stored securely at your lodge.

# Safari Guide & Preparations

## What to Wear

Lightweight, breathable clothing in **neutral tones** – khaki, beige, and olive work best in the bush

**Long-sleeved shirts and trousers** for sun protection and insect deterrence throughout the day

**Warm layers** for cool early mornings and evenings – temperatures drop considerably before dawn

**Rain jacket** recommended during the wet season (November to April)

## Tour Timings

Game drives begin at **first light (~6:00 AM)** and run through to late afternoon. Your same expert guide-driver will accompany you for the entirety of your safari – consistency that builds trust and deepens the experience.

## Packing Essentials

01

### Clothing & Footwear

Neutral shirts, long trousers, sturdy hiking boots, wide-brimmed hat, polarised sunglasses, and swimwear

### Toiletries & Health

High-factor sunscreen, insect repellent, personal medication, and basic first aid supplies

03

### Electronics

Camera with spare batteries, binoculars, phone and charger, and a plug adaptor for Botswana's 3-pin sockets

### Documents

Passport, flight tickets, travel insurance certificate, and your personalised itinerary

# Environmental Responsibility

Botswana's wilderness is extraordinary precisely because it has been so carefully protected. As a guest, you play a vital role in preserving it for future generations. Please observe these guidelines throughout your journey.



## No Single-Use Plastics

Plastic bags are **banned in all Botswana national parks**. Bring a reusable bag and minimise single-use plastic wherever possible.



## Conserve Water & Energy

Water is precious in the bush. Take only what you need, turn off taps and lights when not in use, and support the lodge's conservation efforts.



## No Unauthorised Drones

Drones are strictly **prohibited without an official permit**. Please leave yours at home unless you have the appropriate documentation.



## Support Local Businesses

Choose locally owned shops, markets, and artisans wherever possible. Your spending directly supports the communities surrounding Botswana's wild spaces.



## Respect All Wildlife

Never feed, approach, or disturb animals. Always follow your guide's instructions. **Disable GPS and location data** when photographing endangered species.

# Money & Tipping Guidelines

The official currency is the **Botswana Pula (BWP)**. US Dollars are widely accepted at lodges and established tourist operations, though carrying a supply of local Pula is advisable for smaller purchases in villages and at roadside stalls.

ATMs are available in major towns such as Maun and Kasane – but not in remote areas. We recommend carrying **sufficient cash** before departing for the bush.

## Gratuities

Tipping is a meaningful way to express your appreciation to the dedicated people who make your safari exceptional. The following are respectful guidelines – not obligations – but warmly received.

### Groups

**\$35–50 USD per day**, shared amongst your guides and lodge staff as appropriate

### Solo Travellers

**\$10–20 USD per day** for your dedicated guide-driver and supporting lodge team



## Ethical Souvenir Shopping

Before making a purchase, ask yourself three simple questions: **What is it made of? Is it legal to export? Do I require a permit?**

The following items are **strictly forbidden** for export and must never be purchased:

Ivory and elephant products in any form

Animal skins, stuffed animals, or trophies

Coral, protected plants, or endangered species products

Instead, seek out **hand-woven baskets, beadwork, wood carvings, and locally produced textiles** – beautiful, authentic, and fully legal keepsakes of your journey.
